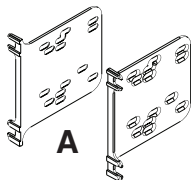

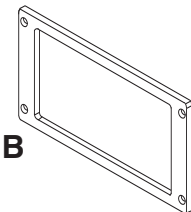


KIT COMPONENTS

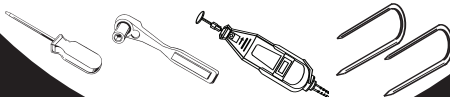

WIRING AND ANTENNA CONNECTIONS (Sold Separately)

TOOLS REQUIRED:

- Phillips Screwdriver • Socket Wrench • Rotary Cutting Tool
- Radio Removal Tools (Part # 86-5618)

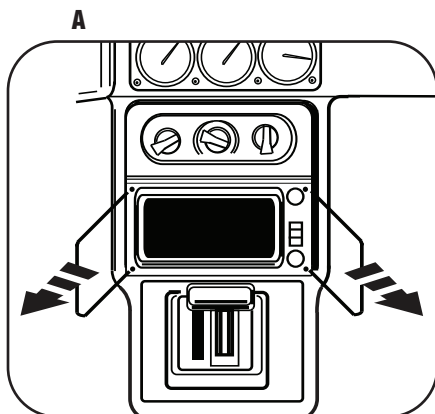


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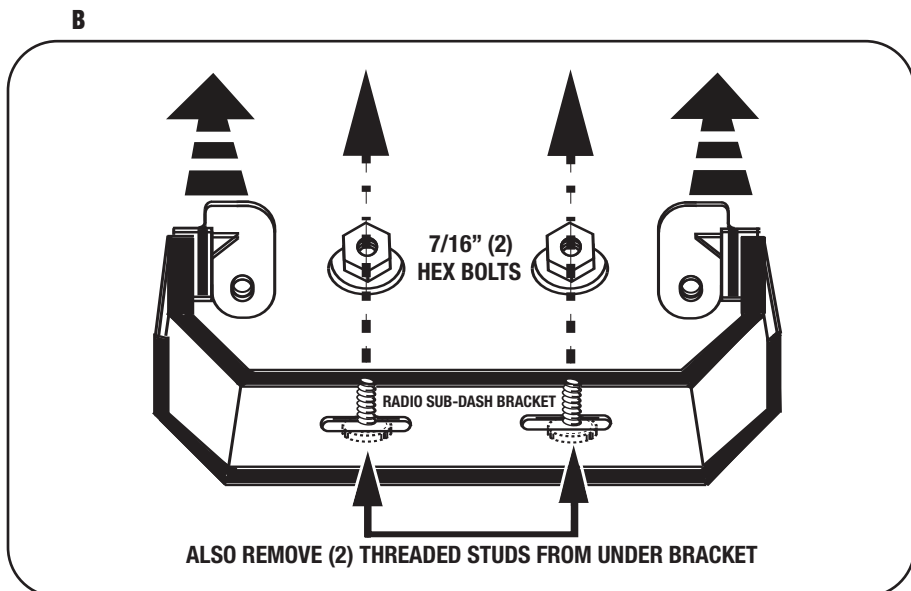
FORD MUSTANG 1987-1993

- 1 Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.
- 2 Using **Metra's 86-5618**, pull the factory head unit from the dash and disconnect the wiring. (Figure A)



- 3 Remove two 7/16" hex bolts from inside the dash cavity and remove the radio sub-dash bracket. (**See recommended tool list on front cover**)
Note: The threaded studs from under this bracket will also need to be removed for the aftermarket Double DIN radio to clear. (Figure B)

Continue to kit assembly.

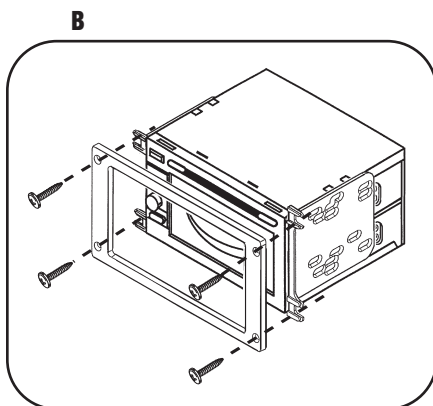
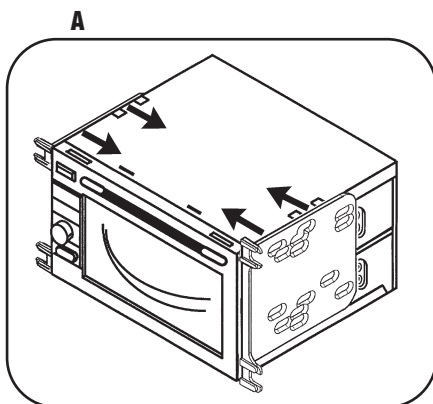




95-5025 KIT ASSEMBLY

DOUBLE DIN HEAD UNIT PROVISION/ ISO STACKED HEAD UNIT PROVISION

- 1 Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra or AXCESS. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- 2 Attach the Double DIN brackets to the Double DIN radio or stacked ISO head units using the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
- 3 Mount the head unit/ kit assembly to the dash using the four supplied # 8 x 1" Phillips screws. (Figure B)



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
